Fast forward to November. The temperature dropped and snow dusted the entire Hobby Farm.

Roger looked out the window and said, "Did you see the hearts in the snow?"

SOS Roadmap

God is using Heart Care to redeem marriages. As a Board we desire to both (I) cling to Lord as He continues to shape and form SOS Marriage Care for His glory and (2) share where SOS Marriage Care is headed and how you can continue to support the Lord's battle for marriages and families through Heart Care.

Acts 1:8 records Jesus' directive to His disciples immediately before He ascended in Heaven: "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."

Wait, what? Jesus expected just a small group of people to figure out how to spread His message of salvation through the entire earth? Yes, He did. But they were not alone. Jesus directed the Holy Spirit to come upon them - empowering them to complete the work before them and He left them a roadmap to follow as they carried out His directive.

"BE MY WITNESSES...IN JERUSALEM"

Originally, the Holy Spirit called SOS Marriage Care to minister in their "Jerusalem" - to those who were in need around them. Roger and Denise soon recognized that Heart Care was a process by which God planned to win back marriage and families far beyond their local sphere of influence. In fact, the Lord was impressing that the ultimate vision of Heart Care was to multiply and function independently in other churches throughout the area. They were being called to move Heart Care beyond Jerusalem.

"...IN ALL JUDEA"

For SOS Marriage Care, going from "Jerusalem into all of Judea" meant equipping other couples to mentor others through Heart Care and preparing others to facilitate Heart Care. God's vision for Heart Care had taken root in their hearts, so they began to equip others to facilitate and mentor using the Heart Care process. Those couples then branched out and took Heart Care to new church bodies and to their friends and families. SOS Marriage Care has moved from Jerusalem and into Judea.

"...AND SAMARIA"

Jesus wouldn't allow his disciples to stay in their comfort zone. He directed them to witness to those that made them uncomfortable. As SOS Marriage Care grows, the work of the Holy Spirit through Heart Care has spread. While it began as a ministry to those within the church,

it has quickly spread to those outside the church whose marriages are failing. This presents a unique question. How do we tailor the truth of Heart Care to a couple that does not see a need for Jesus in their lives or in their marriage? Simple. We don't. The truth of marriage as revealed in the Bible is that it is an institution that God specifically designed to be a picture of the love God has for us and the intimate relationship, He desires to have with us. Even to the individual that does not desire relationship with God, the process of Heart Care presents the gospel message. Over the years, a number of people have been brought to saving faith in Jesus Christ while going through the Heart Care process.

"...AND TO THE END OF THE EARTH"

Taking the gospel to the end of the earth required the disciples to build a Church that was equipped with the structure and vision to last as long as it takes to complete the directive that they received from Jesus. As a Board, we want to be more intentional about expanding the number of local churches that can implement a Heart Care ministry. In addition, we want to actively provide support to those local churches that are already using Heart Care.

In Heart Care, after the couple prays through their bitterness, we have them prayerfully ask Jesus to give them a picture of what their hearts look like, free from the bitterness caused by unforgiveness and the weight of carrying the pain they have experienced. Almost always the person will get a picture of new heart. One wife shared her picture with us.

"My first heart was being strangled and what was coming out was hatred and bad stuff. The second heart was white and there was a garden, a place of thriving and Jesus was there tending to the garden. One of the coolest parts for me was that my husband's heart was able to shine bright for Christ as He allowed the Lord to redeem it. And a garden (my heart) needs the sun (Christ through my husband's heart) to thrive and to grow. So the sun on the second picture represents that. They fit together pretty perfectly.

We are one. This is still hard sometimes but the Lord keeps helping us and working in me."

The first picture depicts a pain filled heart. The heart shows some of the wife's pain words she used to describe her own pain. The heart also has some belts around it with the word "Unforgiveness" written across the middle.

The second heart is redeemed by King Jesus. It is bright, white and cleaned up. The white behind her heart looks as though Jesus himself has taken his own white-out pen and scratched over her sin and pain. The belts are replaced with beautiful flowers, a sign of new life. Near the top, she included her husband's handwritten heartfelt response to her pain. So many Heart Care couples experience similar pictures of their hearts as God cleans out and renews. Hebrews 12:2 states - God redeems all things. Jesus is the founder and perfector of our faith. Thanks be to God!

Recipes

Favorites from the Hobby Farm

Grandma Sadie's Creamed Broccoli Soup

We make this every Christmas!

I pkg. high quality frozen, chopped broccoli

1/2 c. chopped celery

2 T. finely chopped onion

1/4 c. butter

1/4 c. flour

1 1/2 c. milk

1 14-oz. can chicken broth

1/4 tsp. pepper

1/4 tsp. cefery

1/4 tsp. salt

1/2 c. finely chopped ham

1/2 c. shredded cheddar cheese

I. Cook broccoli according to pkg. directions only until thawed, drain well. (We just rinse frozen broccoli with hot water and drain.)

2. Sauté celery & onion in butter until tender, stir in flour, add milk & broth.

3. Heat & stir until thickened and smooth. Add seasonings and drained broccoli and ham.

4. Simmer 10 minutes, stirring frequently.

5. Add cheese and stir until melted.

Yields 5 1/2 - 6 cups.

HSBC's Soup Stew

2 I/2 lbs. stew meat

2 I/2 lbs. potatoes, cut into bite size pieces

I lb. baby carrots or cut up carrots

I lg. pkg. frozen green beans I lg. pkg. frozen corn I/2 bunch celery, sliced

Spray an 18 Qt. Roaster or Roasting pan with Pam Cooking Spray. Place Stew meat on bottom layered with vegetables on top.

Mix together in separate bowl:

2 cans cream of mushroom soup

2 cans tomato soup,

2 pkgs. Lipton Onion Soup Mix

Add:

I can beef broth

5 cans of water

Pour liquid over the top of vegetables and meat. Add more water to cover vegetables if necessary. Cover tightly with foil.

Bake at 325 degrees for 5 hours or 300 degrees for 3 hours in a convection oven.



1-2 oz. mulling spices

32 oz. cranberry juice 12 oz. apple cider 12 oz. dry red wine 1/4 cup brown sugar ½ cup apricot brandy or unflavored

- I. Combine juice, cider, wine & sugar. Stir until dissolved.
- 2. Add mulling spices tied into a square of cheesecloth secured with string or plastic bag tie.
- 3. Heat over medium heat until hot (don't boil). Reduce heat to low and simmer 30-60 minutes, stirring occasionally.
- 4. Just before serving, add brandy and stir. Serve with cinammon stick.

Makes 7 8oz. cups

Tortellini Soup

I pound Italian sausage

I cup chopped onion 2 cloves garlic, minced

5 cups beef broth

½ cup water

½ cup dry red wine (optional)

8 ounces fresh or frozen tortellini pasta

I cup sliced carrots

2 cups stewed tomatoes

½ tsp. dried basil

½ tsp. dried oregano

8 oz. tomato sauce

1 ½ cups sliced zucchini

2 green bell peppers, seeded & cubed

2 Tablespoons chopped fresh parsley

Freshly grated Parmesan cheese for top

- I. Brown sausage and cook until crumbly.
- 2. Remove meat from pot. Reserve I Tablespoon of the drippings.
- 3. Cook onion and garlic in the drippings until tender. Add broth, water, wine, carrots,

tomatoes, basil, oregano, tomato sauce and the cooked sausage. Bring to a boil; reduce heat and simmer uncovered for 30 minutes.

4. Add zucchini, green peppers, parsley and tortellini. Simmer another 25 minutes, covered, for fresh tortellini or 45 minutes, covered for frozen tortellini. Serve with fresh Parmesan cheese sprinkled over the top.

Yields: 12 servings
